GRANTS COMMITTEE

- Assist with identifying grants to fund the Farm to School Initiatives
- Research and apply best practices in applying for and writing grant proposals
- Provide necessary or required follow-up to grant programs

GARDEN COMMITTEE

- Assist with the overall upkeep of the garden throughout the year
- Support teacher-led learning opportunities
- Maintain garden beds appropriate to season and learning-based activities

CHICKENS COMMITTEE

- Provide oversight for the process of obtaining and maintaining the chicken coop
- Establish and maintain policies in agreement with local regulations
- Support educational opportunities related to chickens

BEEES KNEES COMMITTEE

- Provide oversight for the process of obtaining and maintaining a healthy beehive
- Establish and maintain policies in agreement with local regulations
- Support educational opportunities related to bees

FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE

- Work with local businesses to obtain additional financial support
- Establish sponsorship levels that coincide with current initiatives

MARKETING/SCHOOL LIAISON COMMITTEE

- Establish marketing material for use inside and outside of the school
- Function as the main point of contact for school leadership
- Provide communication and marketing for specific events
- Maintain and establish the SFE Farm to School website

FARM TO TABLE COMMITTEE

- Coordinate and host the Farm to Table Dinner Fundraiser
- Work with local venues and vendors to create a Farm to Table experience

COMMUNITY EVENTS COMMITTEE

- Create and host events, in addition to the Farm to Table Dinner, bringing awareness to the program
- Work closely with the Executive Board to implement ideas
